- DC(Handicrafts) vide note at page 4/ante has approved composition of the DSC as follows for considering compassionate appointment:-



- 5. In terms of DoPT OM No. 43019/9/2019-Estt.(D) dated 23rd August 2021, the relative merit points and procedures for such selection being adopted by other Ministries/Departments have been studied and based on it, issued terms of reference vide Museum's O.M. dated 15.12.2021 so as to bring about uniformity in the selection procedure.
